Online Signup for Racing 2 Save Lives Closes Soon!

Online Signup for Racing 2 Save Lives closes on Tuesday, May 10, 2005 at 12:00 Noon, Mountain Time.

Racers who have not yet signed up online for the Racing 2 Save Lives Endurance Event must do so immediately. Signup online now at: www.racing2savelives.org/race.php Spots are filling up fast, and some sessions are already closed to additional signups. You may sign up in person at the racetrack, but are highly encouraged to reserve your spot online. In-person signups will be handled on a first-come first-served basis, and in the interest of safety, track time may be limited depending on the number of participants on that day or time-slot.

The event will run from 9am – 6pm from May 11th to May 13th, allowing riders/racers from across the country to come and contribute towards a great cause, while riding at Pikes Peak International Raceway in Fountain, Colorado. Thereafter on May 14th - 15th, the Motorcycle Roadracing Association (www.mra-racing.org) will host sprint races at PPIR and allow racers to log their laps raced towards our total goal while competing in various sprint class races.
