The track days are split into sessions. Sessions can be purchased separately or in blocks (\$50.00 one session, \$90.00 two sessions, \$120.00 three sessions). The sessions are predetermined by time of day. (9:00-Noon, Noon-3:00, 3:00-6:00) For the truly professional experience, rent a space in the garages for just \$20.00 a day (4 spaces per garage). Keep in mind that Racing 2 Save Lives fully encourages pledges and a donation exceeding the minimum amount requested, but also offers a tremendous experience for a modest dollar.

Racing 2 Save Lives is about safety first. We will have a tech area where bikes must be gauged as track-worthy. Tape up the lights, replace your coolant with straight water, remove your mirrors and have decent tread on your tires.
