### ***Racing 2 Save Lives* Announces Landmark Motorcycle Endurance Race Event For Charity**

Denver, CO – May 4, 2004 – A fundraising event of unprecedented proportion is taking place in late June, 2004 at Second Creek Raceway in Denver, CO. This event will showcase a week-long motorcycle endurance race to raise money for childrens' charities by completing as many miles as possible on a closed-circuit roadracing course.

Local and national motorcycle racers will ride from sunup to sundown for five full days, from June 21 through 25. It is estimated that as many as one hundred racers will participate in this event, and nearly sixteen thousand miles will be logged during the endurance race alone. The event will then continue with a full weekend of AMA-sanctioned sprint racing June 26 and 27 with the Motorcycle Roadracing Association (MRA), where racers will have the opportunity to pledge their miles raced to *Racing 2 Save Lives*. Over four thousand additional miles are expected to be pledged during the MRA race weekend.

In addition to racers, the Colorado Sportbike Club (CSC) will form the event staff for the endurance race. The CSC is heavily involved in local charities, having participated in the Children's Hospital annual Toy Run for three years, and raised nearly one thousand dollars towards the Hospital's Wagon Drive in 2003 alone. CSC members also frequently work at MRA races; as such, it is a natural extension for this group to participate in the *Racing 2 Save Lives* event. The club's members will form the all-volunteer track staff, pit crews, and other people necessary to effectively and safely produce an event of this magnitude.

The motorsports community has never produced an event like this, however the overwhelmingly positive response demonstrates the dedication and caring of everyone in the sport. While racing is competitive by nature, everyone involved has a long-standing history of banding together to help those in need.

*Racing 2 Save Lives* is led by a qualified staff; Tony Baker, Ralph Forsythe, Stan Foxworthy, Sharon Foxworthy, and Hanna Steplewska form the leadership of this organization. All are MRA-licensed racers, and their diverse backgrounds uniquely qualify them to spearhead this amazing charity effort. More information about them can be located on the group's website.

This event has also attracted local and national media attention, with radio and television coverage anticipated. Due to the expected attention an event such as this will gather, sponsors and contributors will receive name exposure wherever possible. The staff will make every effort to recognize the support given by those individuals and companies who will make this event a success for years to come.

This promises to be like nothing else ever attempted before. *Racing 2 Save Lives* is unique in its method of achieving the goals it was created for, and through the hard work and dedication of everyone involved, it will set new standards for what the motorcycle and roadracing communities can contribute.
